

RCL Branch 100 Club Room 'Wall of Honour'

The Branch downstairs lounge was revamped during the 2015-16 period. The initiative was launched early in 2015 when Ken Birch and Dave Wyndham agreed to take on the project. Prior to work getting underway, Jim Sherwood joined Branch 100 and agreed to be part of the refurbishing team.. Work got underway in the Spring with the removal of all the wall pictures, ceiling tiles and the old broken baseboards. Ken's wife Elisabeth and Dave's wife Lois also assisted, while Jim's wife Debbie made sandwiches to provide nourishment for the team.



New ceiling tiles were installed, the lounge and bathroom were given two coats of paint, and new baseboards were installed.

A Legion obligation associated with the Brighton Memorial Park Cenotaph Project was to create a **Wall of Honour** in the Branch to display plaques that had been proudly displayed on the old Cenotaph in Memorial Park. The plaques included the Sir Arthur Currie 1926 Cenotaph dedication Plaque; the Korea War Memorial Plaque; and, the WWI and WWII Ultimate Sacrifice large metal plaques.

The Canadian Forces Base in Trenton refurbished the old Cenotaph plaques and Dave Wyndham designed the Wall of Honour; created other plaques (attached) to compliment the old cenotaph plaques; constructed a mounting bracket to display the flags; and, created a scaled drawing for Jim Sherwood and Brian MacKenzie to install the items. The stained glass Poppy that is part of the display was created by Comrade Barbara Graham, who had managed the Memorial Park engraved paver project.
